

 We have an obligation to prepare our students to be responsive to a continually changing world and take agency of themselves, their communities, and society as a whole.




 We aim to prepare students for any reading and writing task they will face or set themselves and work to turn them into lifelong confident readers and writers who display agency and independence in future endeavors.











