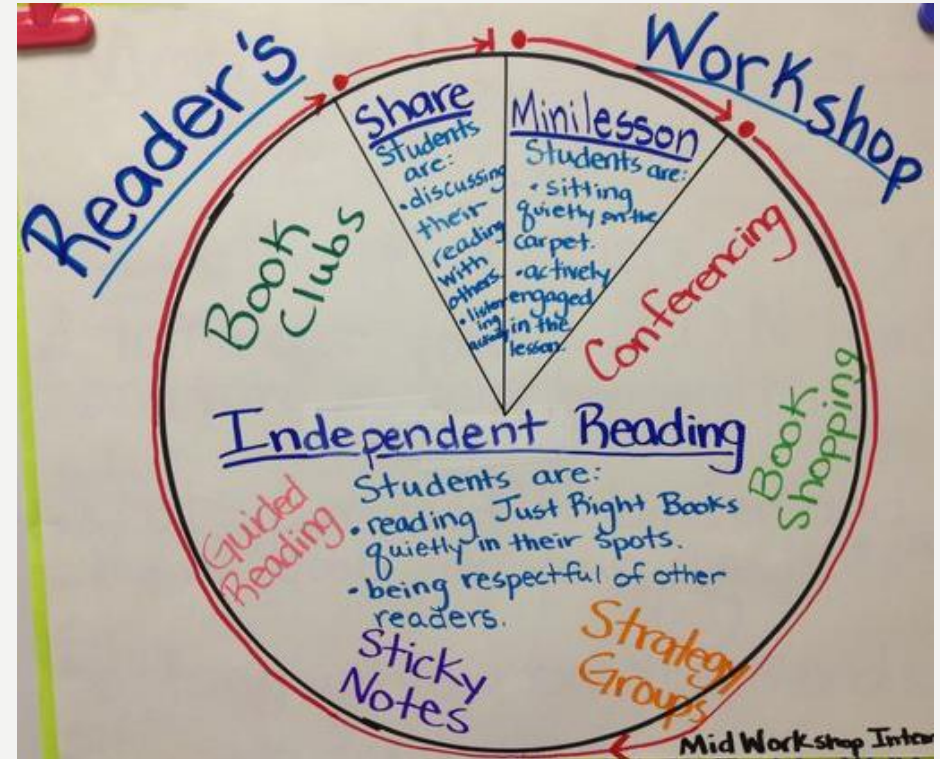
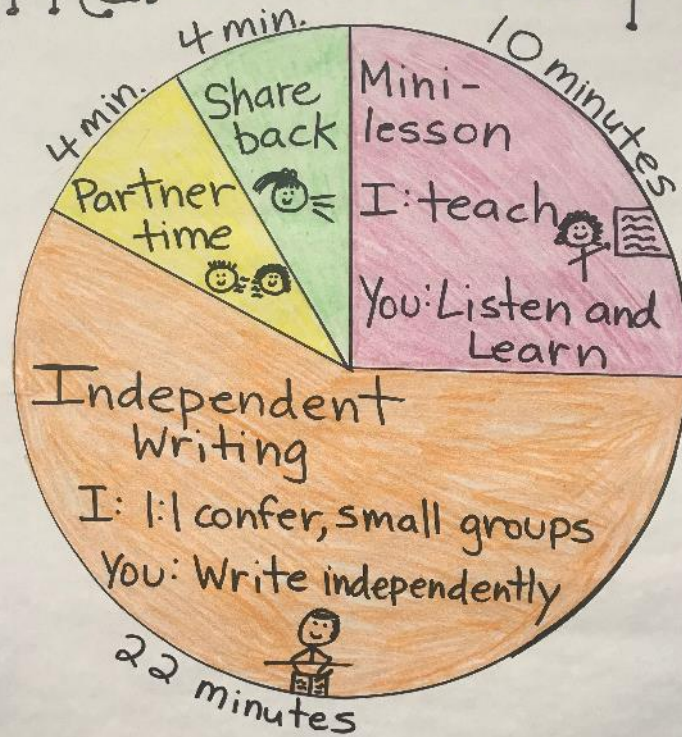


- We have an obligation to prepare our students to be responsive to a continually changing world and **take agency of themselves**, their communities, and society as a whole.
- We aim to prepare students for any reading and writing task they will face or set themselves and work to turn them into life-long confident readers and writers **who display agency and independence** in future endeavors.

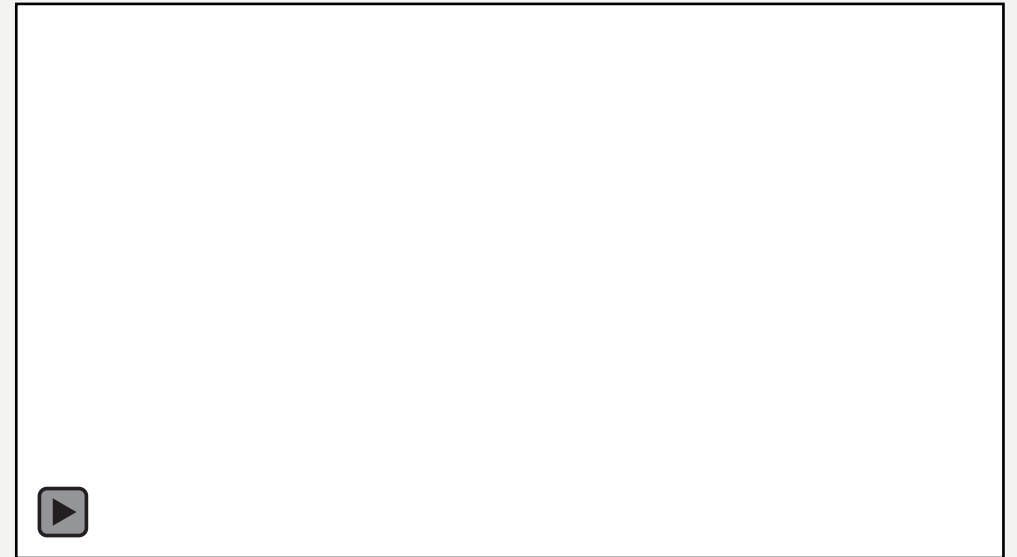
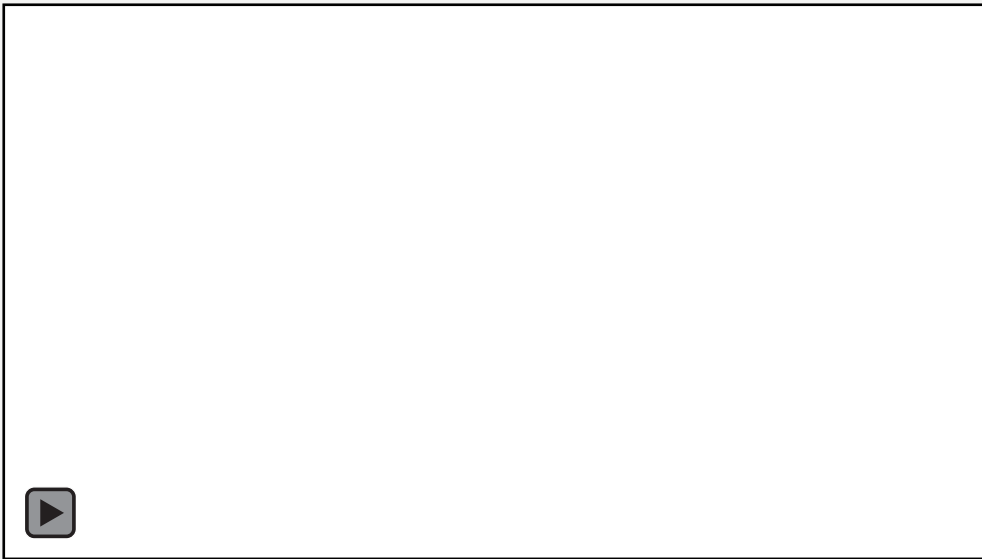

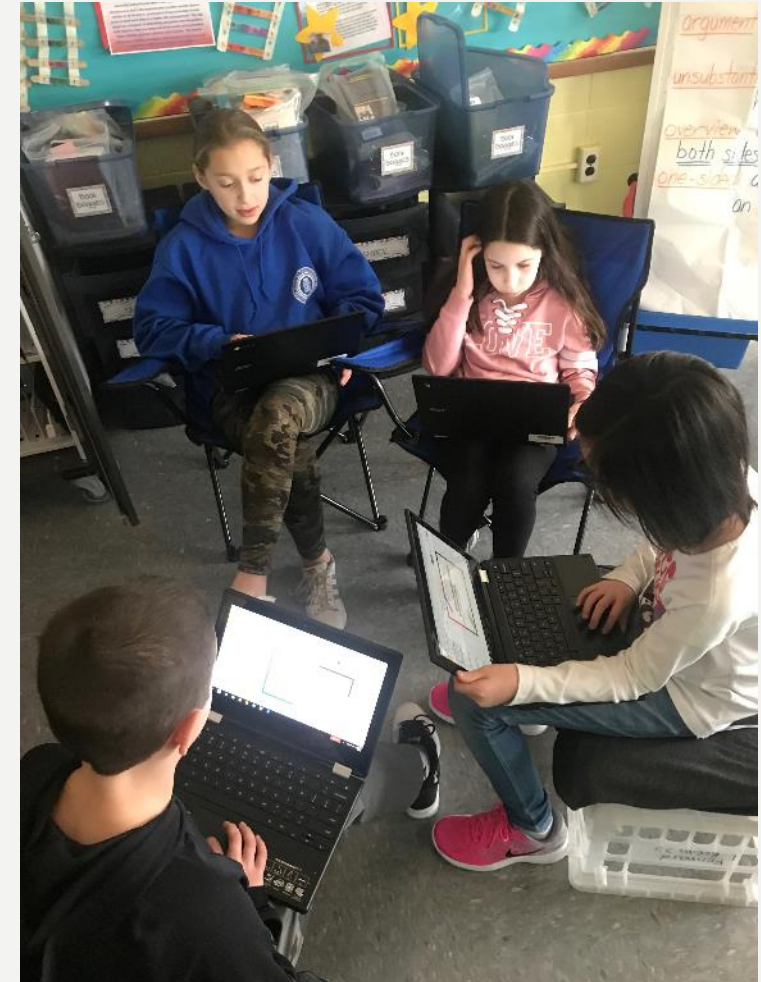
