






Re-initiate Teachers College reading and writing program. Extend program into middle school.


Grades 3-8 Math Proficiency




Math 3-7 Proficiency by Cohort




Grade 3-8 ELA Proficiency






Grade 8->9 Transition Improvements

- Specific criteria for honors classes, especially Geometry;
- Review curriculum in Geometry Honors (the last revision was 2014);
- Opportunities to meet with guidance counselors earlier in the transition process, including individual meetings with middle school counselors;
- ► Holding the "9th grade orientation" meeting much earlier in the year to provide time to discuss course options with parents.
- Updated and searchable on-line and hard copy course guides for parents to better illustrate course progressions through high school.


Math Regents Exam Scores




Humanities Regents Exam Scores
