Dear Parents/Guardians of Grade 3 & 4 Students,

This year, students will participate in the paper-based 2024 New York State Grade 3-5 Assessments. The state assessment results will be used solely as a measure of student learning and not for student placement. Each assessment will be administered in two sessions and is structured in a multiple-choice, short response, and long response format.

Syosset Central School District has created the following schedule within the NYSED testing windows for administering each assessment:

Students may take as much time as needed to complete the untimed, individual assessment. Below are some suggestions to help your child put forth their best effort, and we invite you to reinforce these suggestions at home:

- Students should not worry about receiving a “grade” on these assessments. They should be reminded to relax and simply do their best.
- Students focus best when they are well rested and nourished. A good night’s sleep and a nutritious breakfast are always important.
- If a student is absent from school on the date of the assessment, they will be able to take the make-up assessment upon return to school and within the NYSED testing window time frame.

If you have decided that your child will not participate in any or all of the New York State Assessments, **please inform the main office of your child’s school in writing by Wednesday, March 27, 2024.** We cannot accept these notices via e-mail. This advanced notice will allow us to make appropriate arrangements in order to honor your request. Students not participating in an assessment will be allowed to participate in quiet, independent reading while the assessment is being administered throughout the building.
