



NYS Portrait of A Graduate





Current Model





Districts can add local requirements and withhold diplomas from students who do not meet those requirements.

Credit Requirements

• 22 credits earned through units of study

Assessment Requirements

Regents and Local Diploma

- Pass 5 Regents exams or
- Pass 4 Regents exams and complete 1 pathway

Regents Diploma with Advanced Designation

- Pass 8 Regents exams or
- Pass 7 Regents and complete 1 pathway



Proposed Transformational Model

Districts must confer diplomas to students who satisfy the State's requirements.

Changes to Assessments Requirement

- The Regents exams are no longer mandatory for graduation but will remain on the student transcript
- Students must take the Regents exams per Federal requirements



One High School Diploma

- Districts can add, not mandate, additional seals or endorsements
 - Locally developed endorsements
 - Skills-based micro-credentials

• Advanced designation would become a seal or endorsement

NYS currently has the following endorsements:

- With Honors
- Mastery in Mathematics
- Mastery in Science
- Technical

NYS currently has the following seals:

- Seal of Biliteracy
- Seal of Civic Readiness

Sunset Diploma Requirements

- Students will no longer need to "pass the Regents" or a +1 Pathway Assessment to graduate.
- State assessments will continue to be administered per federal ESSA requirements.



SY 2024-2025

- Finalize Portrait of a Graduate
- Exemptions from Diploma Assessment Requirements for Major Life Events (effective June 2025)

SY 2025-2026

 Release details of new credit requirement (phase in with 2027 cohort)

SY 2026-2027

- Prioritized. reformatted learning standards
- Release Portrait of a Graduate rubrics and guidance
- Financial literacy and climate education required

SY 2027-2028

- Sunset diploma assessment requirements
- Redefined seals. endorsements
- Finalize rubrics and guidance for prioritized. reformatted learning standards

SY 2028-2029

- New transcripts with proficiency required in standards and the Portrait of a Graduate (phase in with 2029 cohort)

Fall 2029+

 New assessments aligned to prioritized learning standards
