Dear Dr. Rogers:

The New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (Department) is in receipt of your correspondence dated December 3, 2018 pertaining to the sampling conducted at the Former Syosset Landfill and the Remedial Investigation Report for the Cerro Wire Brownfield Cleanup Site.

Former Syosset Landfill:

The Department is in the process of evaluating the need for radiological sampling at various sites across Long Island, similar to what was performed at the Former Syosset Landfill. Samples were collected at the Former Syosset Landfill and sent for analysis at the end of 2018. The Department is still awaiting the final data usability summary report (DUSR) on the analytical results to be completed. A DUSR is a review of the laboratory analytical results done by an independent party as part of our standard quality assurance protocol. Preliminary results do not show any cause for concern; however, the Department must wait for the results to be validated by the DUSR prior to issuing any report on the sampling event.


Cerro Wire BCP:

Due to an area-wide drop in groundwater levels, the groundwater monitoring wells previously installed on the Cerro Wire property were no longer viable. The Applicant had to install four new wells to complete the groundwater sampling required by the Department-approved Remedial Investigation Work Plan (RIWP). The wells were installed from January 29, 2019 through February 6, 2019 and sampled the following week. Upon receipt of the validated analytical data, the Applicant will have completed the

tasks in the RIWP and will submit a Remedial Investigation Report (RIR). We expect to receive the RIR in May 2019.
